This year, we became Novus. But long before the new name, the new logo, or the new website, we were already living this story.

For years, as Employment Options, our work has centered on a core mission: that people living with mental health conditions deserve more than a job. They deserve purpose, independence, and a place to belong. That idea hasn't changed. What's changed is how clearly we can say it, and how urgently it needs to be said.

Mental health touches every corner of our community. It shows up in the young adult who withdraws from the world before anyone notices. In the family that watches helplessly, not knowing where to turn. In the isolation that's difficult to climb out of. Too many people still face it without support, connection, and a place to belong.

Novus exists to change that through community and the belief that every person has the capacity to grow.

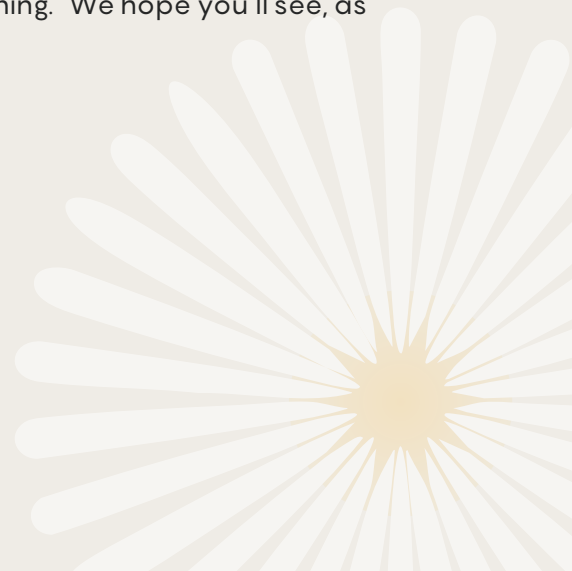
This year, our members, staff and volunteers showed us what that belief looks like in action. In our clubhouses, our kitchens, and locations across the community, they showed up. When government delays disrupted SNAP benefits for families across our state, our community opened an internal food pantry and sent home more than 30 free, nutritious meals a day.

As you read through this report, you'll meet some of the people behind this purposeful work. Like Steve, whose story captures exactly what we mean by "new beginning." We hope you'll see, as we do, that this work belongs to all of us.

Steve's story and the program that made it possible

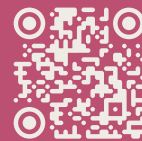
Today, Steve Savoie serves lunch every day to students at Advanced Math and Science Academy, often hearing that the food is one of the best parts of their day.

Novus Catering is a social enterprise creating purposeful employment for members while serving our community with food that's both delicious and impactful.

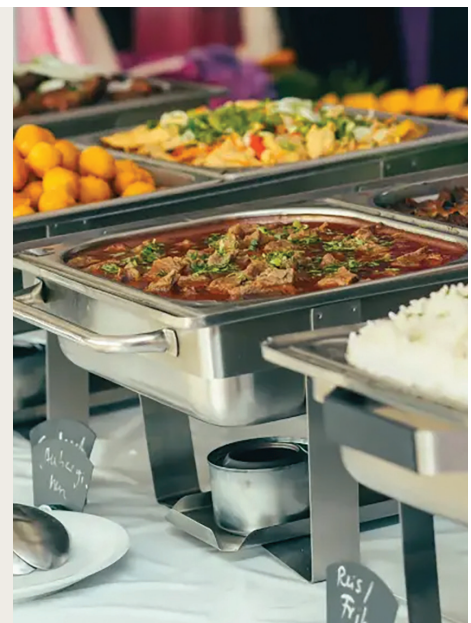
